

- Demand is expected to grow by a further 22% by 2018 as consumers have access to more digital products and services than ever before.

CONSTRUCTION & PROPERTY > SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGNER

- Our built environments need to become more sustainable and your job will be to design new buildings which are as energy efficient as possible.
- Many construction firms have called on the UK government to focus on a low-carbon recovery from Covid-19.
- Almost half of the world's building groups expect 60% of their projects to be "green" by 2021.
